#### PURPOSE OF JALSA SALANA

"The primary purpose of this convention is to enable every sincere individual to personally experience religious benefits. They may enhance their knowledge and - due to their being blessed and enabled by Allah, the Exalted - their perception of [Allah] may progress. Among its secondary benefits is that this congregational meeting together will promote mutual introduction among all brothers, and it will strengthen the fraternal ties within the community."

The Promised Messiah<sup>as</sup> said that one of the aims of the Jalsa is to inspire piety and righteousness. These are lifelong objectives. Another aim of coming to the Jalsa is to gain true understanding of the fear of God. This fear is not that which frightens you but it is the kind of fear that one has of displeasing one's beloved. Another aim of the Jalsa is that its atmosphere should soften the hearts, inspire us to strive for God's love, and foster such harmony and brotherhood that others should look upon us with admiration for demonstrating the true teachings of Islām. The Promised Messiah<sup>as</sup> also taught that his followers should be meek and humble and should cast aside all arrogance and pride. They should attain spiritual heights and then spread spirituality among their countrymen. Opposition cannot stop us from our mission. It is our duty to keep spreading the message of Islām everywhere with wisdom and sagacity.
